


## Fix Favicon and Page Titles

### Enhancement Details:

<b>Current State (Prior to this Release)</b>	The website favicon and page titles are not correctly displaying. 
<b>Problem Statement</b>	Due to an error in the webpage code, the favicon and page titles are not being displayed correctly.
<b>Solution Details</b>	Fix 0011-210 is adding a code fix to correct both the favicon display and page titles.
<b>Customer Impact</b>	Each page will now correctly display the favicon and page titles.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	None.

## Fix Error Messages in On-Demand Reporting

### Enhancement Details:

<b>Current State (Prior to this Release)</b>	Errors in on-demand reports were being displayed in a format that was not consistent with our standards.
<b>Problem Statement</b>	Because the on-demand report display was not consistent, the reports could be confusing.
<b>Solution Details</b>	Fix 0009-210 is being applied to display errors in the standard format and include an informative message. 
<b>Customer Impact</b>	Users will see standard error messages for on-demand reports.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	None.

## Fix Password Reset Instructions with Contact Information

### Enhancement Details:

<b>Current State (Prior to this Release)</b>	After performing a password reset, the user was not presented with instructions for what to expect next or the actions to take when a problem arose.
<b>Problem Statement</b>	Users are unsure of the steps to take when there is a problem with resetting their password.
<b>Solution Details</b>	Fix 0009-210 is being introduced to include the following message when users change their password: If you do not receive your password reset instructions, please contact GHX ePay Support at 888-392-5401.
<b>Customer Impact</b>	The new message makes it clear what to do when users have a problem when changing their password.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	None.

## Add File Name and Exception Reason to Export from Pending

### Enhancement Details:

<b>Current State (Prior to this Release)</b>	The current export from pending does not indicate what file name each invoice came in with. There is also no detail explaining why invoices are pending.
<b>Problem Statement</b>	This functionality was not included in prior versions.
<b>Solution Details</b>	Enhancement 0009-206 adds the file name and exception reason to the export.
<b>Customer Impact</b>	Customers will now see the file name and exception reason for each pending invoice.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	None.

## Supplier Filter on Process Payments Page did not Work Properly

### Enhancement Details:

<b>Current State (Prior to this Release)</b>	When customers used "select all" for the hospital listing on the Process Payments page, the supplier name filter was not working correctly.
<b>Problem Statement</b>	Prior versions had a bug in the code that prevented this functionality from working.
<b>Solution Details</b>	Fix 0011-202 corrects this issue by introducing a code fix.
