
Problem

Changes to the GHX Single Sign On portal login flow process are needed to support future GHX functionality.

Solution


GHX is updating the workflow and design of the GHX Single Sign On portal login screens for login.ghx.com and my.ghx.com. As of August 15, 2022, users will enter their email address on the first screen, and their password on the second screen.

Password reset functionality will also utilize the new design.




This is an example of the first password reset screen.

Starting August 15, 2022, all users who log in to the GHX Single Sign On portal will see an updated design for login entry and password reset flows.




Multi-Factor Authentication

Problem


Some organizations require enhanced security when users access GHX applications and some organizations wish to offer enhanced security as an available option for their users.

Solution


GHX offers multi-factor authentication as an optional organization and user preference. Note that there are some organizations that require this for their users as opposed to it being optional. Examples of three of the multi-factor authentication login screens follow.
